ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (1996) PROCLAMATION – EXTENSION OF ALL LICENSES AND PERMITS

The Minister of Transport, Fikile Mbalula, has issued a proclamation in the Government Gazette (No. 43183) to the effect that the following documents will retain validity for a period of 30 after the date on which the lockdown period expires, despite the fact that they may expire during this period:

1. Drivers' licenses.
2. Learner drivers' licenses.
3. Motor vehicle licenses.
4. Temporary permits.
5. Professional drivers' permits.
6. Roadworthy certificates.

In addition, the validity period for the renewal of a motor trade number licenses will be extended for a period of 6 months after the expiry of the present lockdown period.

All vehicle testing stations and drivers' license centres will remain closed during the lockdown period.
