SANITISATION PROTOCOL

The following sanitisation protocols need to be strictly adhered to at all times.

- Use a sanitiser with a minimum of 70% alcohol as an active ingredient.
- Hands must be sanitised regularly during the day by spreading the sanitiser evenly over the entire surface of both hands and rubbing hands together.
- Hands must be sanitised immediately after any contact with products/parts and or other people.
- When sanitising the workstation before, during and after work, all surfaces, and loose items and stationery must be wiped down with disinfectant as per the regulations.
- Do not share tools, equipment or workstations in the workshop.
- Do not share food or drinks.
- Do not share masks or any PPE.
- Ensure that you clean and sanitise anything else that you may come into contact with.
- Ensure you sanitise hands immediately upon entering or leaving any form of public transport/taxi's.
- Should you be required to drive a customer's car you need to use a sanitiser with minimum 70% alcohol to wipe down:
 - Steering Wheel
 - Hand Brake lever
 - Car keys
 - Seats
 - Gear knob
 - Door handles inside and outside the car
- In addition to the above, we advise also covering these same areas with a protective cover.
