The Department of Energy has released the new fuel prices for September 2020, reflecting the fuel adjustment effective **00H01 on Wednesday, 02 September 2020 (midnight Tuesday 01 September 2020,)**



INCREASE IN THE RETAIL MARGIN APPLICABLE TO PETROL

The Minister of Mineral Resources and Energy has approved a retail margin increase of **5.3 c/l** to be effected in the retail price structures of all octane grades of **PETROL** with the effect from **2 September 2020** to accommodate the increase in the Staff Related Costs in the BSS RAS. The **5.3 c/l** is already included in the projected **1.00 c/l** pump price adjustment.
