FUEL PRICE ADJUSTMENT: Wednesday, 6 April 2022

The Department of Mineral Resources and Energy has released the new fuel prices for April 2022, reflecting the fuel adjustment effective **00H01 on Wednesday, 06 April 2022 (midnight Tuesday 05 April 2022)**

Petrol

93 ULP & LRP 28.00 cents per litre increase in Retail Price
95 ULP & LRP 36.00 cents per litre increase in Retail Price

Diesel

0,05% Sulphur Content 152.56 cents per litre increase in wholesale price
0,005% Sulphur Content 168.56 cents per litre increase in wholesale price

Illuminating paraffin

Illuminating paraffin 266.00 cents per litre increase in wholesale price
Illuminating paraffin 355.00 cents per litre increase in Single Maximum National Retail Price (SMNRP)


250.00 cents per kilogram increase in maximum Retail Price

The Minister of Finance and Minister of Mineral Resource and Energy announced on 31 March 2022 a temporary reduction in the general fuel levy by 150.0 c/l per month on both petrol and diesel until 31 May 2022.
